

CNA TRAINING CERTIFIED NURSE AIDE

Cardinal Services' health care opportunity lab prepares participants for rewarding careers as certified nurse aides (CNAs). The program combines classroom instruction and hands-on skills training in our fully equipped health care opportunity lab with clinical training hours at a local senior community.

The Cardinal Services' program has been approved by the Indiana Board of Health and follows the established curriculum, which includes:

- ♦ Infection control
- Emergency procedures
- Basic nursing skills, such as taking vital signs and measuring height and weight
- Positioning and transfers
- Activities of daily living, such as bathing, grooming and dressing
- Nutrition, feeding and hydration
- ♦ Skin care
- Other essential skills
